

FAMILY ACTIVITIES AND GAMES

FAMILY HOUR (Actually 30 minutes to an hour depending on time)

Each night has a different variation of prayer, praise and activity. Ex: Night 1 – family prayer circle, spend 10 minutes praising God, share a compliment with the person on your left, read a book to the whole family. Night 2 – Let one of the kids pray, praise the Lord by dancing, play “socks off”. Memorize a scripture. Night 3 – etc.

Mattress Night

Drag mattresses to the living room and have a family slumber party. Tell stories about your childhood experiences (all you need is 4 or 5 because your kids will ask to hear them over and over again).

The Tickle Jail

All the kids are in a room. Dad guards the door and pretends to fall asleep. The kids try to “escape” from jail. Dad tickles the kids as he catches them trying to escape. If they do escape, you have to catch them and tickle them back to the jail.

Socks Off

The whole family, with their shoes off, get on the floor, constrained by boundaries suitable for the number of people. The object is to take the socks off everyone else while keeping your own socks on. Last one with a sock still on wins.

Paper Airplane Contest

Kids make paper airplanes and then have a throw off. Give prizes to winners. Ex: Longest single throw, longest combined 3 throws, straightest throw, etc.
